The Club is currently undergoing an exciting golf course reconfiguration project including; 11 new golf holes by Browning Design, new irrigation system, new practice facilities, new clubhouse and maintenance facilities. CNPGCC is seeking a Grow-in Supervisor to manage the grow-in of 9 new golf holes.

SCOPE AND PURPOSE

The Grow in supervisor will work with the team to establish; bentgrass greens from seed, bluegrass fairways and rough from seed and sod, and native fescue areas from seed. The individual will demonstrate a thorough understanding of growing practices including irrigation, fertility, spray applications, cutting, and general soil and turf health. The individual will manage all aspects of water programming and delivery to provide optimal growing conditions. Reporting to the Project Manager and Superintendent, the Grow in Supervisor will contribute to a positive, safe, and professional work environment, and will receive all necessary support to meet grow-in objectives. The individual will devote full effort to achieve objectives with the equipment, budget and direction provided. The grow in supervisor will manage a small team of dedicated staff who will assist with daily tasks.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Respectfully leading a grow-in team. This includes scheduling, training, monitoring and evaluating all maintenance personnel.
- Enforcing compliance with safety program.
- Inspect golf course features regularly throughout the day to evaluate turf conditions, and effect changes in management program to achieve desired standards based on his/her professional interpretation.
- Keeping accurate and complete records of maintenance procedures and applications.
- Coordinating and planning daily, weekly, and seasonal tasks with equipment technician, and the golf management team.
- Meeting regularly with the Project Manager and Greens Superintendent to discuss plans, priorities and strategies.
- Be capable of performing physical work in challenging mountain weather conditions.
